About CWEL

The Center for Workforce Equity and Leadership (CWEL) was established in 2023 in response to growing child welfare workforce challenges related to staff **recruitment**, **retention**, and well-being.

The center is also addressing disproportionality and racism in child welfare, which impacts both child welfare professionals and children and families.

An urgent need in the workforce

- Black, Hispanic, and Indigenous children and parents face overrepresentation and overpolicing in the child welfare system.
- Child welfare professionals don't often **represent** the children they serve.
- Black, Indigenous, and Latinx professionals face implicit bias, microaggressions, and discrimination, often leading to moral injury and burnout.

CWEL's mission

To advance equity and social justice within the child welfare workforce and improve workforce recruitment and retention through site-specific support. This is all while **disrupting** a system that perpetuates **racial injustice**.


